

Subject: CME Credits

Dear Conference Attendees,

We are pleased to inform you that the World Congress on Virtual Rehabilitation, Amsterdam, Netherlands 26/06/2024 - 28/06/2024, has been accredited by the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (EACCME[®]) with 17.0 European CME credits (ECMEC[®]s). Each medical specialist should claim only those hours of credit that he/she actually spent in the educational activity.

Through an agreement between the Union Européenne des Médecins Spécialistes and the American Medical Association, physicians may convert EACCME[®] credits to an equivalent number of AMA PRA Category 1 Credits TM. Live educational activities, occurring outside of Canada, recognized by the UEMS-EACCME[®] for ECMEC[®]s are deemed to be Accredited Group Learning Activities (Section 1) as defined by the Maintenance of Certification Program of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Information regarding the conversion of EACCME® credits

Credit will be converted based on one (1) hour of participation equaling one credit for all activities. Physicians wishing to convert EACCME[®] credits to AMA PRA Category 1 Credit[™] will be required to access the AMA website at<u>https://edhub.ama-assn.org/pages/applications</u> to obtain the necessary paperwork and instructions. Physicians and other health care professionals will be required to pay a processing fee to the AMA.

For other countries, please contact the relevant national/regional accreditation authority.

EACCME® credits

Each participant can only receive the number of credits he/she is entitled to according to his/her actual participation at the event once he/she has completed the feedback form. Cf. criteria 22 of UEMS 2023.07.
